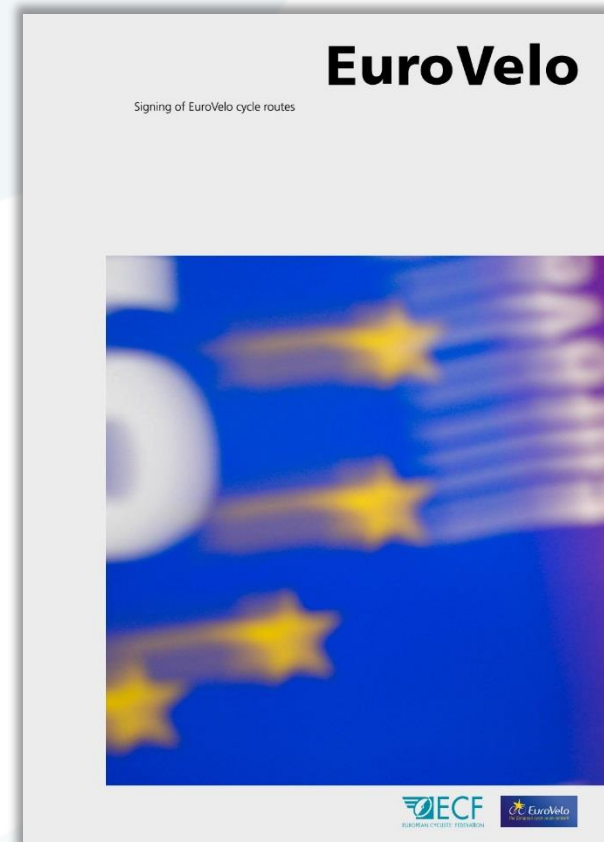


# Updated EuroVelo Signage of EuroVelo cycle routes manual

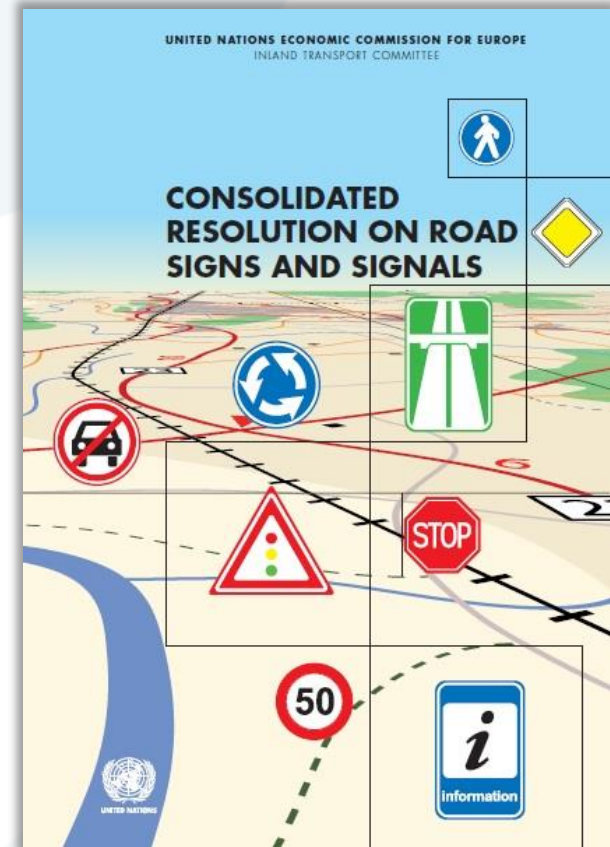
# Signing of EuroVelo cycle routes

- One of the oldest and most popular EuroVelo manuals and consequently supplies were starting to run low.
- In 2016 the ECF secured funding to re-print the manual.
- This provided an opportunity to update the contents where necessary.



# Overview

- Originally the United National Economic Committee for Europe (UNECE) worked with the ECF to produce the recommendation for the signing of EuroVelo routes.
- Included in the Consolidated resolution on road signs and signals (R.E.2).
- Aim: Provide consistent and clearly recognisable signing for the EuroVelo routes to ensure the safe conduct of international and national cyclists.

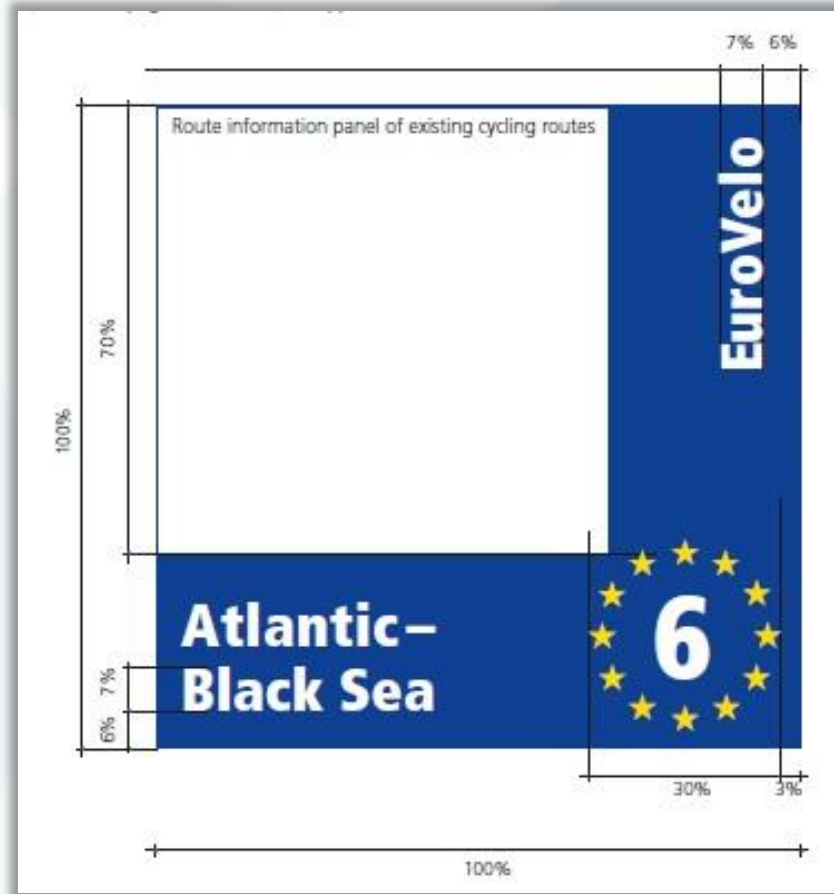

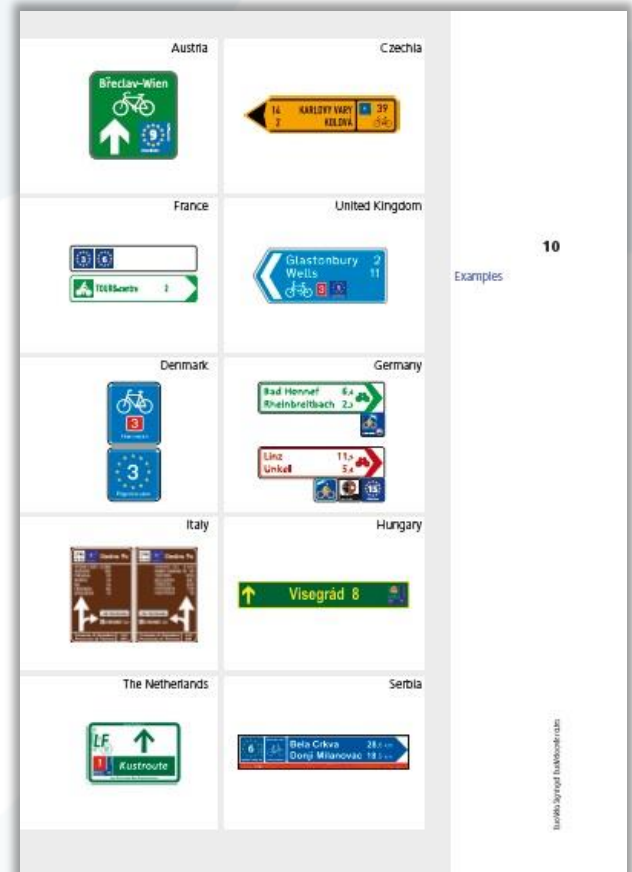
